



WOMEN'S HEALTH TRAINING PROGRAM

July, 2003

The Women's Health Training Program is inclusive of all staff providing services to women in Local Health Department settings. Offered in Five Levels, each level or series of classes builds incrementally up on the previous level. This training includes staff in 5 categories*: **1. All new non-RN staff (clerks, SW, Nutritionist, Health Educators, Interpreters, etc.). 2) New Nurse Managers (hired since July 1, 2001. or assuming managerial role since that date). 3. New staff nurses. 4. Candidates for Enhanced Role Nurse (ERN). 5. Existing Clinic Coordinators/Managers.**
